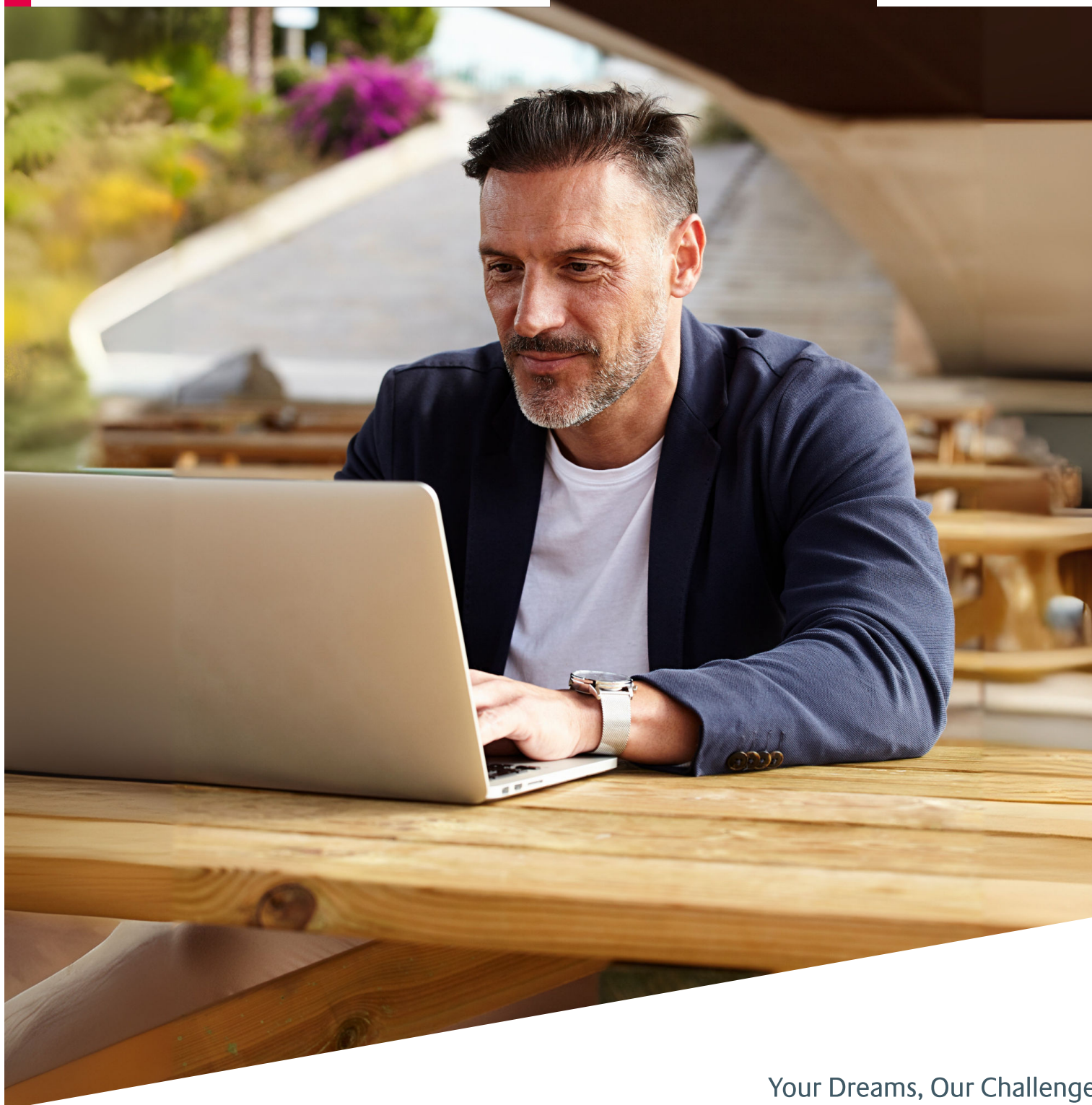

Save your configurations within your projects and share them with your colleagues!

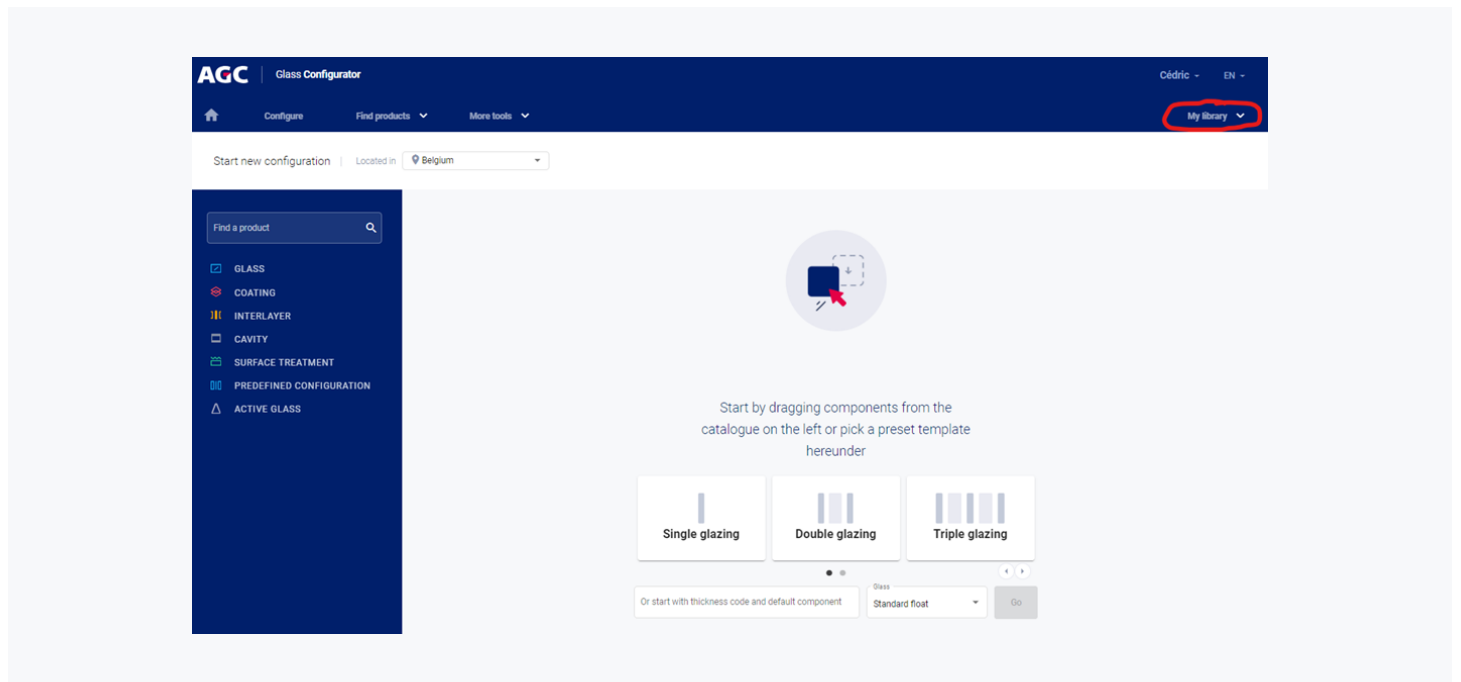

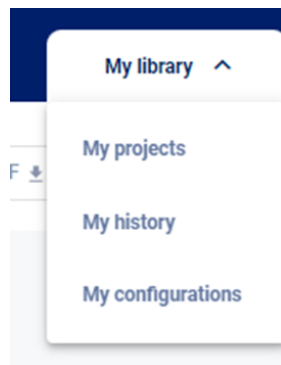
The Glass Configurator allows you to download datasheets of all your calculations in a single go, set up a library featuring all your projects that use AGC glass, and share them with your team.

Click the **My Library** tab in the upper right part of the screen.



My Library is divided into three sections:

- **My projects**
- **My history**
- **My configurations**



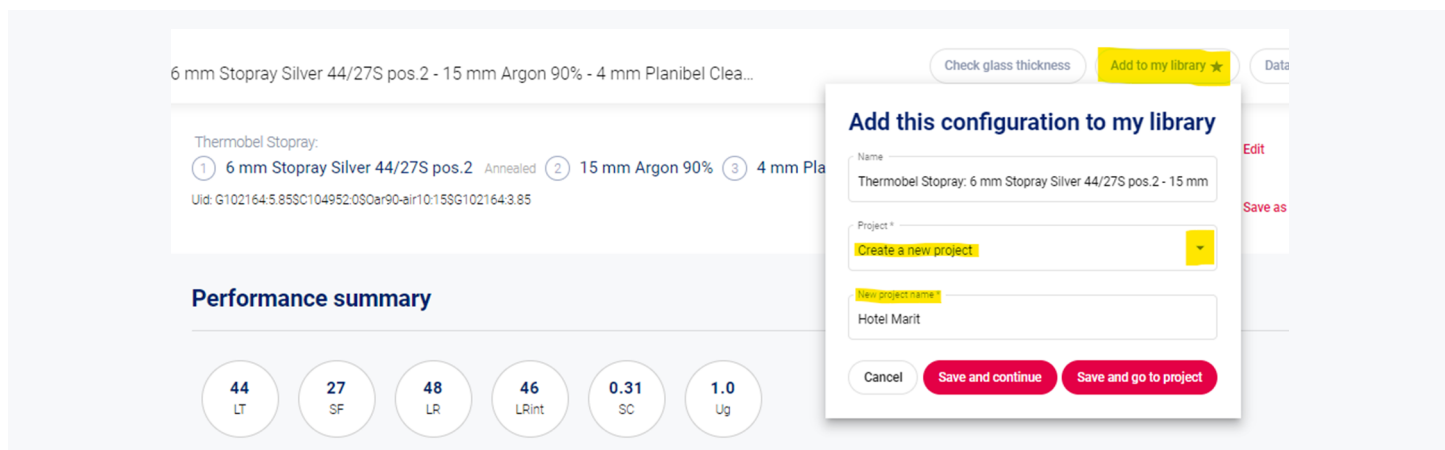
In **My Projects** you can save your configurations (glass compositions) within projects you create yourself. You can then share these configurations with colleagues or partners. Projects function as folders that can hold many different configurations. This makes it easier to update your project in case of changes to specifications or products.

My History is simply a list of the last 20 configurations you calculated. If you forget to save a configuration, or if you need to redo a recent calculation, you can easily find it here.

My Configurations is a page that groups together all saved configurations from the various projects you have created in **My Projects**.

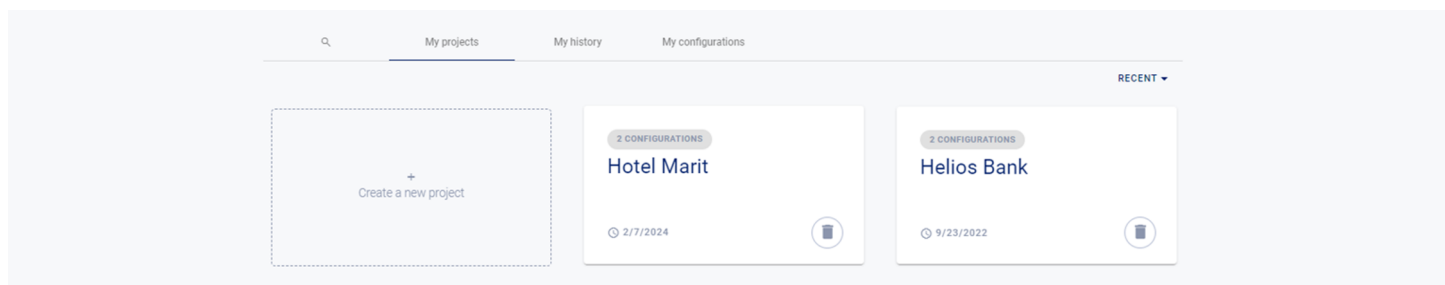
Let's take a closer look at projects, since this is where the most useful functionalities can be found. Keep reading to learn how to start using these features.

Once you've calculated a configuration, you can save it by clicking **Add to my library**. You can either create a new project or save your configuration to an existing project. After saving, you can choose to stay on the configuration page (**Save and continue**) or be redirected to your project page (**Save and go to project**).



Another way to create a project is to simply go to the **My Projects** page and click **Create a new project**. The folder will be empty to start with, but you can add configurations later.

The **My Projects** page displays all of your projects as tiles, with the date created, the number of configurations in the project and a bin icon to delete the entire project.



Within each project, you can click the **Edit** button to add a photo, add a description and specify the client and location.

Click the **Export Project** button to download all the technical datasheets for the glass compositions in the project, grouped into a single PDF file.

Click the **Share** button to copy the project link and share it with your clients and/or partners. In other words, instead of sending PDF documents, you can simply send the project link via email. Anyone who clicks on the link will see the project added to their own library. This is very convenient for keeping your team up to date if any modifications are made to the project. People who have added the project to their library are listed in the **Shared with** box. You can at any time revoke access for anyone who has added the project to their library without your consent.
