AGC guarantees that the paint on its painted glass products is compatible with its FIX-IN bonding solutions (see the FIX-IN warranty for more details). The warranty is five years for Lacobel & Matelac and ten years for Lacobel T & Matelac T.

The range also includes touch-up paints to conceal small scratches in the paint on the glass as well as glass cleaning kits for an installation that is perfect down to the smallest detail.
