

Warranty on AGC toughenable painted glass,

Heat Treated LACOBEL T / MATELAC T

We, AGC

warrant that, for a period of 10 (ten) years from the date of the delivery of Lacobel T or Matelac T glass by AGC to the customer (the "Warranty Period")

- 1. Colour stability of the thermally treated glass installed in exterior or interior conditions shall stay within the following variation of the colorimetric measurements measured on the glass side:
 - \triangleright between adjacent panes of uniform paint: Δ E* ≤ 2,0
 - \triangleright inside one pane of glass of uniform paint: \triangle E* ≤ 1,0
- Glass supplied as single glazing shall not suffer, under normal conditions of use, any of the following alterations ("Defective Glazing") if applied with FIX-IN glass bonding solution in interior applications only:
 - Peeling or crackling of the paint (visible from the glass side).
- 3. This warranty is valid provided that:
 - The glass has been heat-strengthened or thermally toughened before installation by an AGC Certified Processor as listed on www.agc-yourglass.com in *Products* section
 - The glass painting has not been damaged during transport, storage, handling, installation or later on, whether intentionally or accidentally
 - The glass has been specified (e.g. the glass thickness), stored, handled and installed in accordance with the standards or code of good practice in force on the market of use (national regulation), as well as with the instructions given in AGC's documentation
 - The painting has not come into contact with abrasive agents or corrosive chemicals (acids, etc.)
 - > AGC's processing, installation and cleaning and maintenance instructions have been fully complied with
- 4. Should the Lacobel T or Matelac T have been incorporated or assembled in any other composite product (insulating glazing, laminated, partitions, etc.) by a third party, the said third party is responsible for verifying the compatibility of the other materials (sealing glue, etc.) with the painting.
- 5. This warranty is expressly limited to the commitment by AGC to replace free of charge the Defective Glazing at the place of initial supply, or, at AGC's option, to refund the purchase price. In no event shall AGC be liable for any cost of removal, re-fabrication and reinstallation, etc., which are expressly excluded from the warranty.
- 6. Replacement glazing shall carry the same warranty as the initial shipment (no extension of the original warranty period).
- 7. AGC reserves the right to have any glass, alleged to present a Defective Glazing, inspected by a qualified representative appointed by AGC and/or to return said glass to any factory of its choice in order to conduct tests and to determine the cause of the Defective Glazing.
- 8. Any wider warranty given by a third party (expressed or implied) shall not imply an extension of the warranty from AGC.
- 9. Any transaction between AGC and a customer is subject to AGC's general sales conditions available on www.agc-yourglass.com. In case of any discrepancy between AGC's general sales conditions and this warranty, the latter shall prevail. The customer's terms & conditions are expressly excluded.
